



# SLAA Spring Camp-Out

Blanco State Park

April 28<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup>

**Blanco State Park** is a 104.6-acre park, along a mile of the Blanco River, on the southern edge of the serene little town of Blanco, Texas. It is approximately 40 miles from Austin and 50 miles from San Antonio. The park features nature trails, horseshoes, sand volleyball, and a man-made lake that is great for swimming, canoeing, and fishing. Restrooms, hot showers & camp store are available. The town of Blanco also offers quaint cafes and shops as well as basic conveniences. **This is not roughing it!**

**If you want to come but you don't want to camp overnight:** There is no cost, other than a \$4 entry fee per person which is paid at the front gate. Just come for the day and relax and bring as much food as you want to eat or share for the pot-luck picnic dinner.

**If you want to camp overnight:** We have reserved one screened-in shelter. You can stay in the shelter or bring a tent, but each site is limited to the first 8 people who reserve a spot. The cost for camping is \$12 per person, plus the \$4 per person entry fee paid at the gate, which covers the campsite rental fees, hot chocolate and s'mores by the campfire, and a group breakfast.
